Dear Cook Families,

We're into our last month of school, both remotely and onsite. It's hard to believe that we have actually reached this point in the school year with all the unusual situations that have occurred. As a community, we have adjusted and shifted to continue to support our students' well-being and learning. I thank you for your ongoing understanding and cooperation.

Below is important information and dates about various June activities and tasks.

1. **Friday, June 19 – Last Day of the Online Learning Plans (for all students)**
 - A few more general, end of year activities will be sent by teachers for students to participate in the last week

2. **June 22-25 – Last Week of Onsite Learning (students who are attending school onsite)**
 - a) Students who have been coming onsite 2 *days* a week will attend **one day** of onsite learning during the last week of classes:
 - ***Mon/Tues group:*** Students who have been coming onsite to learn on Mon/Tues will come to school Monday, June 22 only
 - ***Thurs/Fri group:*** Students who have been coming onsite to learn on Thurs/Fri will come to school Thursday, June 25 only
 - ***6/7 students:*** Division 1,3,4 will come onsite on their regularly assigned day. Div.2 will attend on Wednesday, June 24 (instead of Friday, June 26).
 - b) Students that have been attending school onsite 5 *days* a week will attend Monday-Thursday during that final week of classes.

3. **June 22-25 - Student Belongings (for all students)**

During this week, **ALL** students will be given the opportunity to pick-up their personal belongings from the school and to:

<u>Return</u>	<u>Pick Up</u>
-iPad (with case, charging block, charging cable)	-Report Cards
-Library books	-Epi-Pens
-Cook-loaned band instruments	

This is also a chance for staff and students to say goodbye in person and put closure to a memorable school year. **Please look for further details from your child's teacher as to your scheduled time, date and location to pick-up belongings.**

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4. June 22-25 – School iPad Return

Students that borrowed school iPads (with cases, charging blocks and charging cables) are asked to return their devices at their scheduled appointment time given by your child’s teacher. **Parents must sign the equipment loan form when returning iPad(s). The iPad(s) will be assessed for damage and will be disinfected when they are returned to the teacher.**

5. Return of Library Books

There is a bin outside of Door #4 (North end/Kindergarten wing) where students may drop off any library books they have at home. The bins will be emptied regularly throughout the week. Mrs. Storey has posted detailed information on the Portal.

5. Term 3 Report Cards

All students will receive a year-end report card. Student assessment and evaluation have been varied this term and as such, the information on the report card will be different than what has been provided in the past years. Term 3 Report Cards will be distributed during the week of **June 22-25**. Some students will receive a paper copy of their report card while others will have it uploaded to their student portfolio by their teacher.

Summer/Fall Requests

July – August: Our School Garden

If your family is available to sign up for a week of watering, weeding and harvesting for approx. 1 ½ - 2 hours twice a week to support our school garden, please contact the office. We can assign you a week that works for you and your family. Parents must accompany their child when volunteering to work in the garden. There will be another adult there to help supervise these tasks.

The attached form is to be completed by any families who will be late returning to school in September (after Sept. 9 but before Sept. 16, 2020). Please return to the Office by **June 25, 2020**.
