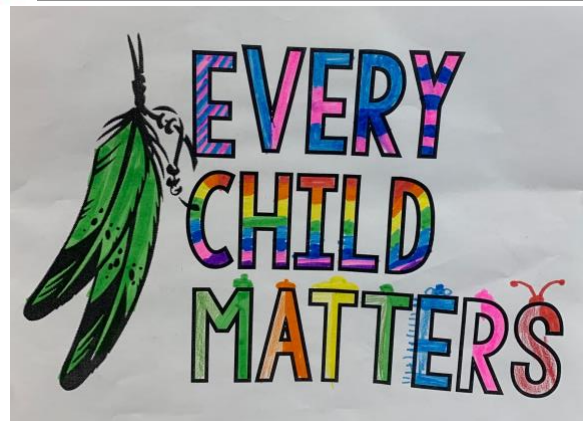

The devastating news of the remains of 215 children found at the Tk'emlúps (Kamloops) Indian Residential School in British Columbia is reflective of Canada's cruel and gruesome history that lingers.

At the request of Kukpi7 (Chief) Rosanne Casimir of the Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc First Nation the colour orange is being worn to remember the lost children, as well as flags are being lowered across the nation to honour them.

While these actions show visible support and solidarity, rectifying cultural genocide cannot be evoked without action. Reparations for the children lost to residential schools, and survivors, are ongoing.



Grade 7 Farewell

We will be celebrating the end of our Grade 7 students' elementary education and the beginning of their secondary school experience on June 23 at 5:30 p.m. via Zoom. Our Grade 7s will also have a small celebration (students only) in their pod earlier that day.

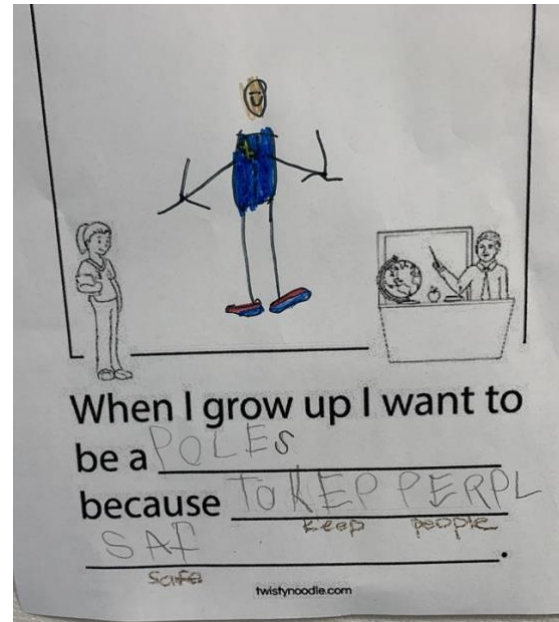
Ms. Miran’s Division 20 Kindergarten class investigated shades of orange and created orange shirts in support of our indigenous children.
