What's the difference between CONFLICT and BULLYING?

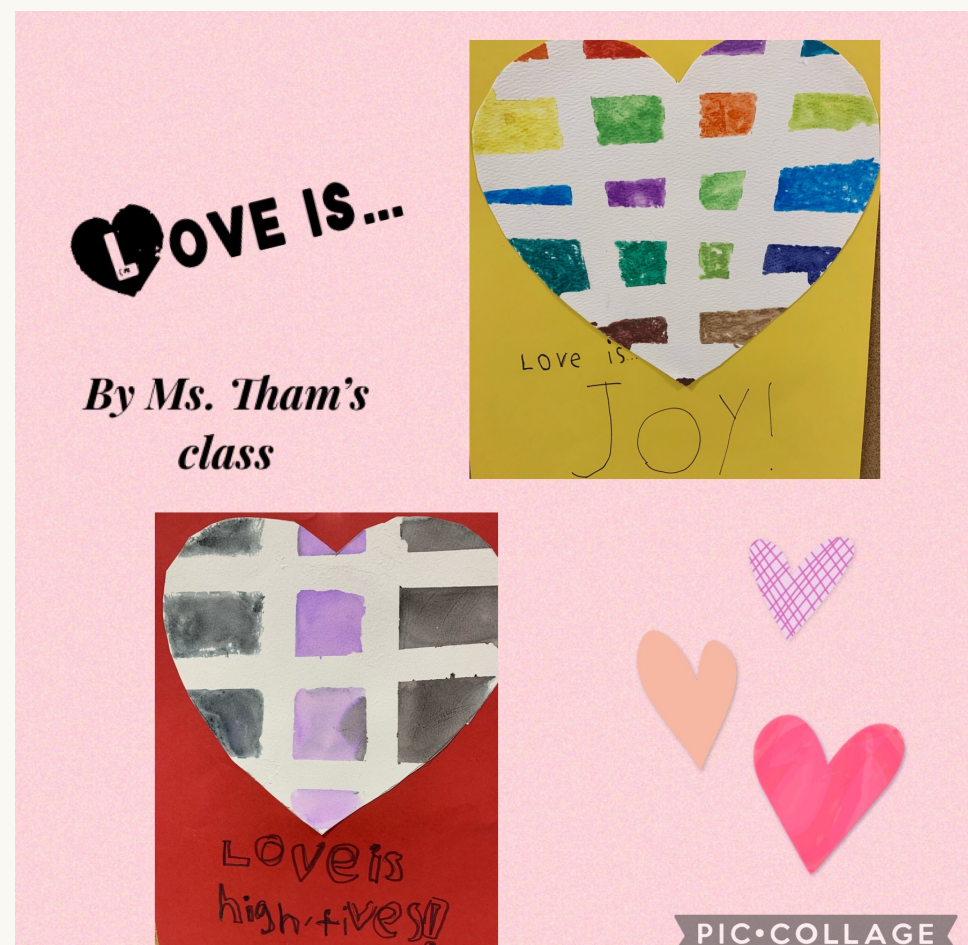
Conflict happens occasionally and is usually not serious or emotionally damaging to either person.
